

EMB CONDUCTS WATER SAMPLING ACTIVITIES IN PALAWAN

The Provincial Environmental Management Unit (PEMU)-Palawan conducted a series of water sampling activities on February 16 and 17 to several sampling stations in the province.

The said activities were conducted to monitor the present water quality status of the water bodies in Palawan as part of the EMB's mandate under the Republic Act 9275, otherwise known as the Philippine Clean Water Act of 2004.
